You promised paradise to the thief who repented; bring all our sisters and brothers to the joys of heaven.

*All: Hear us, Lord.*

For our sisters and brothers who were washed in Baptism and anointed with the Holy Spirit; give them fellowship with all your saints.

**All: Hear us, Lord.**

They were nourished with your Body and Blood; grant them a place at the table in your heavenly kingdom.

**All: Hear us, Lord.**
